ORIGAMI WORKSHOP

A one-day workshop on Origami, the art of folding paper without cutting or pasting, will be conducted by Florence Temko on May 9, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the University of California, San Diego Crafts Center. All materials will be supplied.

The workshop is open to the public and will include instructions for making the popular flapping bird and other toys, a flower arrangement, a butterfly, a gift box and other useful and decorative objects. Special attention will be paid to individual requests, whether from beginners or from more experienced crafters.

Florence Temko is an internationally known expert on origami and has given hundreds of hands-on programs in colleges, museums (including the Metropolitan Museum of Art), and schools. She is the author of "Paper Pandas and Jumping Frogs (Origami and Its Uses)", her 22nd book about paper arts and folk crafts.
