JUBILATION! DANCE COMPANY TO PERFORM AT UCSD FOR ONE NIGHT, MARCH 4

The Jubilation! Dance Company of New York will perform at the University of California, San Diego, at 8 p.m. Saturday, March 4, in the Mandeville Center Auditorium.

The 10-member group is led by 27-year-old Kevin Jeff, who stands in the tradition of early-modern choreographer Martha Graham, with influences from Alvin Ailey.

Jeff's repertoire contains a wide range of work, including a biographical piece, "Nia Keii" (A Gift of Life), which pays tribute to the birth of a niece; "Aisatnaf," a man's solo piece for a woodland creature who "revels in his surroundings"; "Dedication," a tribute to black children murdered in Atlanta between 1979 and 1981, and "Flack," a half-hour work about black street life, presented against the songs of Roberta Flack.

Tickets for this event are \$15 for general admission, \$12 for seniors and \$10 for students, and may be purchased at the UCSD Box Office (534-4559) or at TicketMaster outlets. This event is brought to San Diego by the UCSD University Events Office.
