TOP COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL MATHEMATICIANS HONORED AT AWARDS CEREMONY MAY 5 AT UCSD

Anna Salamon of San Diego High School and teams from La Jolla Country Day School, La Jolla High School and Torrey Pines High School were top award winners in the 40th Annual High School Honors Mathematics Contest.

One hundred five students from 16 San Diego County schools participated in a half day of math tests April 26. Awards were presented May 5 at the Ida and Cecil Green Faculty Club at the University of California, San Diego.

Salamon was the highest individual mathematics scorer. Jondou Chen of La Jolla High was second, and Max Lin of La Jolla Country Day and Madeleine Price of La Jolla High tied for third.

The team from La Jolla Country Day topped the small schools category, followed by teams from The Bishop's School, second, and San Diego High, third. La Jolla High was the top city school team, with teams from University City High School, second, and Gompers Secondary School, third. The county schools were led by the Torrey Pines High team, with teams from Orange Glen High School, second, and Granite Hills High School, third.

The contest was sponsored by the UCSD Mathematics Department and the Greater San Diego Mathematics Council. Other schools participating were Bonita Vista High, Carlsbad High, Eastlake High, Helix High, Hoover High, Mt. Cannel High, and Rancho Buena Vista High.
