 Place Esquire are hold and firmly bound unto Thomas Hall  
 late of the Parish of Saint James in the County and Island  
 aforesaid but now of the Kingdom of Great Britain Esquire  
 in the Sum of Twenty Thousand Pound Current Money of  
 Jamaica to be paid to the said Thomas Hall his certain Attorney  
 Executors Administrators or Assigns for the which Payment well  
 and truly to be made We bind ourselves and each of us for the  
 whole and in gross the Heirs Executors and Administrators of  
 us and each of us jointly and severally firmly by these  
 Presents sealed with our Seals and Dated this Thirteenth Day  
 of April in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and  
 Sixty Five.

The Condition of this present Obligation above written  
 is such That if the above bound Murdoch MacLeod and George  
 Lofelis or either of them their or either of their Heirs Executors or  
 Administrators shall and do well and truly pay or cause to be  
 paid unto the above named Thomas Hall his certain Attorney  
 Executors Administrators or Assigns the full and just sum of  
 Seven hundred and thirty Seven Pounds Ten shillings Current  
 Money of Jamaica upon the first Day of May which will be in  
 the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and Sixty Six  
 being the first year next at the Time due and payable by the  
 said Murdoch MacLeod and George Lofelis for a Term in the said  
 Parish of Westminsterland known by the Name of Kirkpatrick  
 & Capers and Stock belonging thereto, Leased to them by the said  
 Thomas Hall according to the Condition or Covenant contained  
 in one certain Indenture of Lease bearing even Date with these  
 Presents and made or intended to be made between the said  
 Thomas Hall by the Name and Description of Thomas Hall late  
 of the Parish of Saint James in the County of Cornwall and Island

subsequent years next payable by them for the said Ten Acres  
and Acre in and by the said Indenture of Lease and that by Half  
Yearly Payments That is to say the Sum of three hundred and Sixty  
Eight Pounds fifteen Shillings like Current Money on the first Day  
of November and the like Sum of three hundred and Sixty Eight
