"Post-War Journalism: Is Your First Amendment Missing In Action?" A free public forum sponsored by the Society of Professional Journalists & UCSD will be held on April 2 from 7 - 8:30 p.m. at UCSD's Graduate School of International Relations & Pacific Studies auditorium. The program, which will be moderated by Channel 39's Marty Levine, will include a discussion panel of media experts and members of the media who were directly involved in covering the war. The panel will explore the impact the war has had on the journalism profession and how the restrictions on freedom of the press have had a crippling and lasting effect on the media.
