

Drama Department extends run of two plays

The current productions of "Midsummer Night's Dream" and "Caucasian Chalk Circle," presented in repertory by the Department of Drama at the University of California, San Diego, have been extended by one performance each to meet the demand for tickets.

Eric Christmas, Lecturer in Drama and director of "Midsummer Night's Dream," said the extra performance of each play was "due to the tremendous response we have received from the public." The Shakespearean comedy opened May 1 and ran for eight performances. "Caucasian Chalk Circle," directed by Tom McCorry, opened May 2 and ran for seven performances.
