GENNADY GERASIMOV, SPOKESMAN FOR MIKHAIL GORBACHEV, TO SPEAK AT UCSD

EVENT: Gennady Gerasimov, spokesman for USSR President Mikhail S. Gorbachev, will discuss such issues as: the present successes and weaknesses of glasnost and perestroika; who may want to invest in the USSR; how American foreign policy will have to change to meet its stated objective to cooperate with glasnost and perestroika and what younger Americans should know about the changes occurring in the Soviet Union.

DATE: April 10, 1990

TIME: 8 P.M. Lecture will last approximately 45 minutes, followed by a period of questions and answers.

PLACE: UCSD Main Gym

COMMENTS: Gerasimov has requested that there be no press conference; however, well-positioned media seating will be available during the lecture. He will answer questions from the media after the lecture, during the Q&A period. A microphone will be available. Photographs may be taken after the lecture.
