UCSD QUEST INTERNATIONAL '92 TO BE HELD OCTOBER 23

The University of California, San Diego's International Center will hold the sixth annual "Quest International" on Friday, Oct. 23 from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Quest International, which is free and open to interested members of the public, is the center's study/work/travel abroad information fair which is held every year at UCSD's International Center. This year's Quest will bring representatives from more than 40 international programs to the campus to meet with interested students, faculty and community members.

A wide variety of U.S. university study abroad programs, including the University of California's Education Abroad Program, and foreign universities, as well as intensive language, academic internship, and work abroad programs, will be represented at the fair.

In addition to the exhibitors, a special International lunch will be held, sponsored by Council Travel and the Council on International Educational Exchange (CIEE). This year, a raffle will also be held, with prizes provided by local vendors.
