

## Elizabeth Manchester featured in concert

The Early Music Society of the University of California, San Diego will present an evening of music by Bach, Handel and Vivaldi at 8:30 p.m., Friday, July 14, in room 2722, Undergraduate Sciences Building in Revelle College. Admission is \$1.00.

The concert features Elizabeth Hamilton Manchester, harpsichordist, and Henry Kolar, violinist. They will play Baroque chamber and solo music in addition to some contemporary music composed for the harpsichord.

Elizabeth Hamilton Manchester, formerly a member of the harpsichord and piano staff at UCLA, teaches at Mesa College. Next fall she will be teaching at Grossmont College.

Henry Kolar is a former concertmaster of the San Diego Symphony and the Sherwood Hall Orchestra. Presently he is on the faculty of Mesa College and the University of San Diego College for Women.

Kolar studied at the Academy for Music and Arts in Vienna and is now working on his Ph.D. in music at the University of Southern California.
