DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNICATION SPONSORS REGENTS' LECTURER'S FILM SERIES

A Hungarian drama-documentarist will lecture on documentary approaches to social problems, and show four of his films, Oct. 24-30, at the University of California, San Diego.

Pal Schiffer, whose work depicts the plight of people who live on the fringes of society, will appear as a Regents' Lecturer, sponsored by the Department of Communication. The four films included in the series are: "Gyuri," "The Model Gardener," "Let Me Rest In Peace," and "Cowboys." All films, with the exception of "Cowboys," will have sub-titles. Schiffer will narrate "Cowboys."

Schiffer's schedule of events starts on Friday, Oct. 24, with the film "The Model Gardener," (104 min), shown at 3 p.m. in room 201, Media Center. At 4 p.m. Monday, Oct. 27, his film "Let Me Rest In Peace," (93 min), will be shown in Peterson Hall, room 104. At 8 p.m. on Tuesday, Oct. 28, "Gyuri," (96 min), will be shown in Mandeville Center Auditorium, followed at 9:30 p.m. by a public lecture on "Documentary Approaches to Social Problems." On Thursday, Oct. 30, Schiffer's most recent film, "Cowboys" (224 min), will be screened at 7 p.m. in room 201, Media Center, Third College.
