

UCSD to host pre-Olympic volleyball match

The USA Women's Volleyball team, the United States' entry at the 1996 Olympic Games in Atlanta this summer, will play one of its final pre-Olympic matches at the University of California, San Diego, May 10.

The Americans will host the national team of China, also bound for the '96 games, at 7 p.m. in the RIMAC Arena.

Coached by Terry Liskevych, the USA women won a bronze medal at Barcelona in 1992 and are considered a gold medal threat in Atlanta. The team, which trains in San Diego, is led by '92 Olympians Lori Endicott, Tara Cross-Battle, Tee Williams, Elaina Oden, Caren Kemner and Paula Weishoff.
