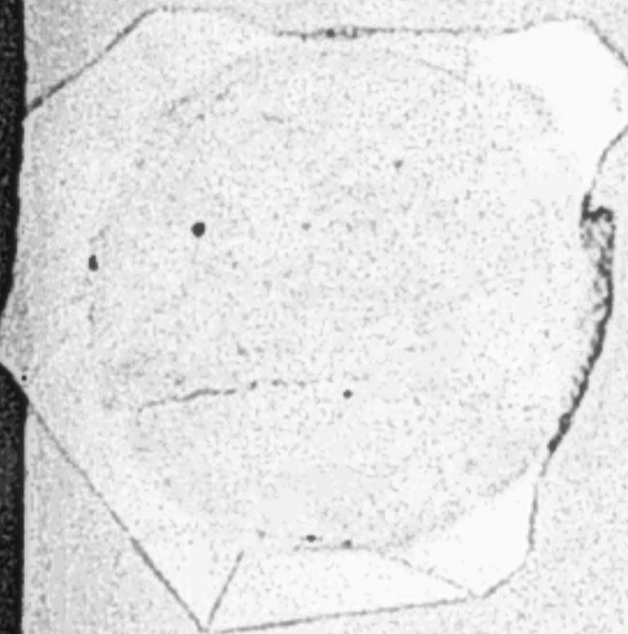

To Hugh Kirkpatrick - - Esq: Greeting

By Vertue of Full power, and Authority to me deriv'd from his Most  
Excellent Majesty George, by the Grace of God of Great Brittain, France and Ireland  
King and of Jamaica Lord, Defender of the Faith &c: Having reposed special Trust  
and Confidence, in your Experience, Courage, Conduct, Fidelity, and Skill in military Affaires  
have Constituted and appointed, and by these Presents, do constitute and appoint you the said  
Hugh Kirkpatrick to be Captain - of a Company - rais'd and to be rais'd in  
the parish of St James's in the Regiment whereof Hon: James Heywood Esq: Colonel  
and to conduct, command, traine, discipline, and exercise the said Company and to do and  
perform all other things belonging to the Duty, Place, and Office of a Captain following  
and observing all such Orders and Instructions, as you shall from Time to Time receive from  
my self or other the Superior Officers, and all inferior Officers, and Soldiers belonging to the said Company,  
are hereby requir'd to obey your Commands, as their Captain according to the rules of Warr,  
and Trust hereby reposed in you: Given under my hand and Seal at Armas, at S: Jago de la Vega  
this sixteenth day of November In the Tenth Year of his Majestys Reign, anno Domini
