King and of Jamaica Lord, Defender of the Faith &c^a: having reposed special Trust
and Confidence, in your Experience, Courage, Conduct, Fidelity, and Skill in military Affairs
have Constituted and appointed, and by these Presents, do constitute and appoint you the said
Hugh Kirkpatrick to be Captain - of a Company - raised and to be raised in
the parish of St Jamss in the Regiment whereof, Hon: James Heywood Esq: Colonel
and to conduct, command, traine, discipline, and exercise the said Company and to do and
perform all other things belonging to the Duty, Place, and Office of a Captain following
and observing all such Orders and Instructions, as you shall from Time to Time receive from
my self or other the Superior Officers, and all inferior Officers, and Soldiers belonging to the said Company,
are hereby requird to obey your Commands, as their Captain according to the rules of Warre
and Trust hereby depos'd in you: Given under my hand and Seal at Armes, at S^t: Jago de la Vega
this Sixteenth day of November In the 27th year of his Majestys Reign anno Domini
