UCSD CRAFTS CENTER/GROVE GALLERY TO SPONSOR UCSD FACULTY/STAFF JURIED PHOTOGRAPHY EXHIBITION, MAY 22-JUNE 20

Camera buffs among the 50,000 or so people associated with the University of California, San Diego are being invited to take part in the UCSD Photography '87, Student, Faculty, Staff and Alumni Juried Photographic Exhibition, to be held May 22-June 20, at the UCSD Crafts Center/Grove Gallery.

Entries are due for jury by May 8, at the Grove Gallery, between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. On May 12, jury and award notifications will be mailed. On May 15-16, from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., and on May 19-21, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. the claiming of unaccepted entries will take place.

On May 22, a reception will be held at the Grove Gallery, from 6-8 p.m. The general public is invited. There is no charge.

Awards will include a Chancellor's Purchase Award, an Undergraduate Affairs Purchase Award for Best Depiction of Student Life at UCSD, a University Center Purchase Award for a permanent collection on campus, and a UCSD Recycle Co-op Award for Nature and Wildlife, in black and white or color (1st, \$100; 2nd, \$50; 3rd, \$25). Jury members will be Carlos Reyes and Alan Decker, UCSD photography instructors for the UCSD Crafts Center.

The exhibition will consist of photographs or other work that is predominantly (90 percent) photographic in composition. Black and white or color work will be eligible. Slides or transparencies will not be accepted.

All entries must be matted without glass or frame in either horizontal or vertical format. Each artist may submit three works for consideration. Each entry must have attached to its reverse side an official entry form. Due to limited gallery space, a uniform submission size of 18" by 24" is required; image size is unrestricted. Mat texture and color are not restricted as long as the photo can be tightly covered with glass or mounting.
