

Israeli Independence Day Folk Dance Festival to be presented

April 25, 1979

The Israeli Independence Day Folk Dance Festival will be presented at 8:30 p.m. Saturday, May 5, in the Mandeville Auditorium at the University of California, San Diego.

Shlomo Bachar and the Hadarim Dance Troupe will present the history of Israel in an evening of dance, music and song. The troupe's repertoire includes the traditional Yemenite and Chassidic dances as well as contemporary Israeli dance. The costumed dancers are accompanied by a live band and vocalists.

Free refreshments from Calliope's Coffeehouse will be served. General admission is \$2.50 and tickets for UC San Diego students cost \$2. Tickets are available at the UCSD Central Box Office and at the door.

Following the performance, a free folk dance will be held in the Main Gym. The performance and the open dance are sponsored by the UC San Diego Department of Physical Education and the Union of Jewish Students.
