

Dr. Edward L. Winterer appointed vice chairman of Dept. of Oceanography at Scripps.

Dr. Edward L. Winterer, associate professor of geology at the University of California, San Diego, has been appointed by UCSD Chancellor John S. Galbraith as vice chairman of the Department of Oceanography of UCSD's Scripps Institution of Oceanography.

A native of Oakland, Calif., Dr. Winterer joined the UCSD faculty in his present position in July, 1962, after having served since 1953 as acting assistant professor, assistant professor, and associate professor of geology at the University of California, Los Angeles.

Dr. Winterer's undergraduate and graduate work was done at UCLA, from which he received his A.B. degree in 1948 and his M.A. and Ph.D. degrees in 1954, all in the field of geology.

Dr. Winterer served as Fulbright Lecturer in Geology at the University of Louvain, Belgium, in 1960.

He is chairman of the West Coast planning group of the Joint Oceanographic Institutions Deep Earth Sampling (JOIDES) program and is a member of the American Association for the Advancement of Science and of the International Association of Sedimentologists.
