

Memorial service for Gloria Liebrez

A memorial service for Gloria Liebrez, director of the Career Planning and Placement Center at the University of California, San Diego, who was found slain outside her home on Labor Day, will be held at 4 p.m. October 3 at the International Center on campus.

Members of the campus community as well as the general public are invited to attend the nondenominational service which will feature brief remembrances of Ms. Liebrez by friends and colleagues of hers.

Ms. Liebrez came to UC San Diego from the University of San Francisco. She was largely responsible for improving student contacts with the business community through such yearly events as "Work Opportunity Week" and seminars and individual counseling to aid students in finding jobs upon graduation.

During her three years at UC San Diego she became one of the most popular administrators on campus working actively on behalf of improving opportunities for students.

The Gloria Liebrez Memorial Scholarship endowment has been established in her memory to provide partial funding to a selected student entering medical school. Contributions to the fund may be made through the UC San Diego Foundation, c/o the Development Office, Q-011, La Jolla, California 92093.
