

Two Students Garner Top Prizes in UCSD Libraries' Annual Book **Collecting Contest**

Bibliophiles James Tracy and Thomas Trudgeon win awards for Darwin and poetry collections

UC San Diego graduate student James Tracy and undergraduate Thomas Trudgeon collected First Prize (in the graduate and undergraduate divisions respectively) in the UCSD Libraries' Annual Student Book Collecting Contest. Tracy, a history graduate student focusing on Science Studies, is a three-time 1st prize winner in the graduate division (the Cole Prize). His collection on "Charles Darwin: A History of Biography and Interpretation," builds on his previous prize-winning collections on "The Great Monkey Trial," and "Darwinism, Evolution, and Religion." The Cole Prize was named for Barbara Todd Cole, the longtime owner of the landmark John Cole's Bookstore in La Jolla, as well as a longtime supporter of the library.
