

Dr. Allen Lein to deliver 5th Professors' Inaugural Lecture

Dr. Allen Lein, Professor of Medicine at the School of Medicine, University of California, San Diego, will present the fifth lecture in the Professors' Inaugural Lecture Series to be held at 4:15 p.m. on Thursday, November 13, in the Humanities-Library Auditorium, Revelle College.

"The Thyroid, For Example" will be Dr. Lein's topic.

Dr. Lein, who also serves as Associate Dean for Administration in the School of Medicine, joined the UCSD faculty in August, 1968, coming here from Northwestern University. He spent 14 years as a professor at Northwestern's Medical School and in 1960 was appointed Director of Student Affairs. He was appointed Assistant Dean of the Medical School in 1964 and was appointed Assistant Dean of Northwestern's Graduate School in 1966.

Dr. Lein, a graduate of UCLA, is a member of the Bank of America Giannini Foundation Medical Advisory Panel, the American Physiology Society, the American Chemical Society, the American Association for the Advancement of Science, the Endocrine Society and the Society of General Physiologists.

The lecture will be free and open to the public.

Dr. Edward L. Winterer, Professor of Geology and Chairman of the Department of Scripps Institution of Oceanography, will be the next PILS speaker on December 4. His topic will be "Wandering Continents and Vanishing Seas."
