BACKGROUND: UCSD has received a donation of computer equipment worth more than \$2.4 million as part of a national \$32 million program conducted by AT&T Information Systems.

Announcement of the gift will be made during a ceremony in the office of UCSD Chancellor Richard C. Atkinson.

The donated equipment ranges from AT&T's 3B20 super- minicomputer to the desktop 3B2 super- microcomputer. Appropriate terminals and high-speed networking products to link the 3Bs also are part of the donation. A computer similar to the equipment being donated to the campus will be set up in the Chancellor's office for demonstration purposes.

Attending the ceremony will be UCSD Chancellor Richard C. Atkinson; Raleigh Wilson, AT&T Information Systems branch manager for San Diego; Dr. Lea Rudee, dean of the Division of Engineering at UCSD, and Donald Anderson, coordinator of academic computing at UCSD.
