5:30 - 6:00 PM.

A car drove up to front of apartments. A man jumped out of his car a van passed me where i was seated reading my newspaper. Then three border patrol officers came running. They asked if i had seen where suspect ran to. I said i didn't know. All three officers pulled out guns when they reached doorway to carport. I realized my daughter was playing in the carport I said Hey! my little girl is back there. Then officer [REDACTED] told me to "shut the fuck up and get in the house". I screamed again that my daughter was out there. Again Officer [REDACTED] said "Shut the fuck up and get in your house". My brother came from upstairs to see what was matter. My brother asked what was going on. Officer [REDACTED] yelled "Shut the fuck or I'll put your ass in van". My brother said "If you think you can." "Do it." While



they argued. I ran and got my daughter. By this time my other daughter was screaming and crying hysteretically for fear that something was going to happen to me or her sister. Between

6:30 - 7:00 pm: Border Patrol Supervisor, Border Officer, and Sheriff Officer came to my door and asked if they could search my apartment. I let them search only because i was afraid not to.

8:00 p.m.

Supervisor of border patrol agents came to talk to us. My two sisters my brother, myself, my mother was also present. Everyone was present except my mother when all the comotion was going on. He said we had to understand the officers ( [REDACTED] ) adrenalin was going and that was the reason why the officer spoke to me the way he did. Also he (supervisor) said that he was responsible for all actions made by his crew.



When asked why his crew refused to give thier names. He said that everyone here could read. Then he said that he didn't have to come and talk to us but he did so because that the kind of person he was. Every time he was asked a question. He never gave a straight answer. He asked us to understand the position of officer. Also i would like to say that he was not present when everything happened.
