### UCSD HOSTS FIFTH ANNUAL COLLEGE FAIR

Representatives from more than 40 California colleges and universities will be on campus to provide information to prospective students when the University of California, San Diego hosts its yearly College and University Information Fair on Thursday evening, October 23.

The fair will be held in the Recreational Gym, next to the Main Gym, from 7-9 p.m. Admission is free and all transfer students and San Diego area high school students and their parents are welcome. More than 800 students attended last year's event.

The fair, now in its fifth year, is sponsored by the UCSD Educational Opportunity Program/Office of Relations with Schools.

Special meetings to discuss admissions to the University of California, the California State University System, and private schools will be held at 7 p.m. and 8 p.m. and meetings to discuss financial aid will take place at 7:30 p.m. and 8:30 p.m.

"The comprehensive, up-to-date information available at this college fair program can help students make better choices of schools when they apply for admission," according to fair coordinator James LaJoie, an outreach officer with the Relations with Schools Office at UCSD.

Among the estimated 45 colleges to be represented will be most campuses of the University of California, along with San Diego State University, and several of the local community colleges.
