

## A Spring Chamber Music Festival - three concerts - will be held at, UCSD May 22-24

## May 18, 1973

The University of California, San Diego Theater will resound with gospel and soul music when the "Inspirational Gospel Ensemble" from South San Diego presents its concerts at 8 p.m., Friday and Saturday, May 25 and 26.

Four members of the ensemble supplied the music for the UCSD Black Theater production, "Day of Absence," presented during the Winter Quarter. "The enthusiastic response to their music prompted us to request special performances of the full ensemble," said Dr. Floyd Gaffney, UCSD drama professor who directed "Day of Absence."

"The 200-seat theater is an excellent facility for the presentation of music which inspires audience involvement," said Gaffney.

The activity is co-sponsored by the UCSD Drama Department and Campus Program Board. Tickets are \$1.50 and are available at the Drama Department office, 203 Matthews Campus (Theater), or the Urey Hall box office on the Revelle Campus of UCSD.
