As an update, I would like the UCSD community to be aware that the investigation is on-going to identify the person(s) responsible for the fake bomb that was found on Wednesday in the Leichtag Building at the School of Medicine. The Campus Police Department is working closely with the San Diego Police Department and the FBI on the on-going investigation. There is no current or increased need for alarm or concern, and we need the campus community to stay specifically focused on our work here at the University which is teaching, learning, research, and service. However, we do have power through our tight knit campus community to support our law enforcement team.
