

Mr. V. Wayne Kennedy named to newly created post of Director of Planning and Budget for UCSD Chancellor

Mr. V. Wayne Kennedy, associate vice chancellor for health sciences and associate dean of the School of Medicine at the University of California, San Diego, has been named to the newly created post of Director of Planning and Budget for UC San Diego by Chancellor Richard C. Atkinson.

The appointment is effective February 1, 1981 pending approval by the University Board of Regents at its meeting January 16 in San Francisco.

Kennedy joined the UC San Diego School of Medicine staff in 1973 after 12 years at the University of Maryland where he served in the Department of Physics and Astronomy, as assistant comptroller and, for three years, as assistant dean of the University of Maryland School of Medicine.

At UC San Diego he has had overall administrative responsibility for the School of Medicine dealing with fiscal, budgetary and planning activities. He has also served on a number of campus, University of California systemwide and federal committees on fiscal and governmental affairs.

As head of the new Office of Planning and Budget, Kennedy will bring together the budget office and the departments of academic planning, administrative records, capital budget and space management, and internal audit and will provide administrative liaison with the UC San Diego Board of Overseers and the UC systemwide administration.

Kennedy has served as national chairman of the Association of American Medical Colleges' group on business affairs and its professional development committee. He is currently a member of the UC systemwide committee on research management, the national committee on governmental relations board of management, and a consultant to the federal Bureau of Health Manpower.

Kennedy is a graduate of the University of Maryland where he majored in industrial management. He and his wife, Florence, have two children. They are residents of La Jolla.
