Amaral is one of the founders of the PPD Party (a non-Marxist, proAmerican party) in the Azores. He is also president of the Political Commission of San Miguel, the largest island in the chain that makes up the country, a member of the Regional Secretariate and advisor to the Judicial Counsel of the PPD.

He was elected President of the Azores in September 1976 at the age of 33.

During a one-day stay in San Diego the president visited the Point Loma Lighthouse, met with members of the tuna industry and spent some time at Sea World as well as visiting the UC San Diego campus.
