

"Twelfth Night" presented in special program

"Twelfth Night," Shakespeare's festive play of romance and misdirected love, will be presented in a special program at 2 p.m. Saturday, Feb. 16, at the University of California, San Diego.

The program, sponsored by the Psychoanalytic Institute of San Diego, will include a panel discussion titled "Literary Conventions About Love." Eric Christmas, professor of drama at UC San Diego and director of the play; Michael Addison, chairman of the Department of Drama at the university, and Drs. Robert Nemiroff and Saul Karlen of the Psychoanalytic Institute, will discuss the dramatic and psychoanalytic implications of the play.
