

Jason Saunders to speak on "The Ancients, the Moderns and What There Is"

The third in a series of free public lectures that is bringing hundreds of San Diegans to the Art Center in La Jolla will be given at 8:00 p.m. Monday, November 18.

The speaker will be Jason L. Saunders, Professor of Philosophy at the San Diego campus of the University of California. Saunders will speak on "The Ancients, the Moderns and What There Is."

The series on philosophy is sponsored by the UCSD Committee for Arts and Lectures with the cooperation of the newly-founded UCSD Philosophy Department. Large audiences have attended the two previous lectures which are open to the public.

Born in Boston, Dr. Saunders attended the Public Latin School there, Tufts University, and Columbia University where he won his Ph.D. in 1952. He had a distinguished record of service with the infantry in the European theater of operations during World War II. He taught at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill before coming to UCSD this year.
