Thank you for your letter of May 17th, confirming our telephone conversation. I shall be pleased to keep you advised when the Silver Transfer Tax is repealed.

According to the legislation as it now stands, H.R. 5389 states that the repeal of the Silver Transfer Tax provisions of the law "shall apply only with respect of transfer after the date of the enactment of this title". If the bill is passed by the Senate in this form and signed by the President, it seems to me that you may still have to pay a transfer tax on the profit on the sales of any silver purchased before the bill became law.

We will be pleased to supply you with silver in the United States, Canada, London or Mexico, when the Silver Transfer Tax is repealed.
