

Music Department to present second annual Mondo Violino Concert

The second annual Mondo Violino Concert, an exploration of string sounds, will be presented by the Department of Music, University of California, San Diego, at 8:30 p.m. on Saturday, February 15, in Building 409, Matthews Campus.

This concert will be the sixth in a series of concerts produced in conjunction with a graduate seminar in performance and conducting problems.

William Mullen, assistant concert master of the San Diego Symphony, is the producer of this program, which is free and open to the public.

The program for the concert will include: Pavanne (1969) by William Mullen, with Alan Johnson conducting; Sonatina for Violin and Piano by Schubert, with Mullen as violinist and Mimi Tung as pianist; Pleiades for Flute and 8 Fiddles (19-0-7) by Mullen, featuring Peter Middleton as flutist; Serenata for Flute, Viola, Contrabass, Percussion and Harpsichord (19S8) by Petrassi, with Middleton, Mullen, Alan Goldman, Jon Grimes and Betty Wong performing; A Piece for Guitar Soloist by Frescobaldi, with Lee Ryan; and Four Pieces for Violin and Piano (Op. 7) by Anton Webern, with Mullen and Miss Tung.
