

Study of Psychopharmacology offered during the six-week Summer Session

June 1, 1981

A study of psychopharmacology is being offered this summer by the Summer Session at the University of California, San Diego.

The course will develop basic principles in psychopharmacology while exploring the behavioral effects and mechanisms of action of these drugs. Emphasis will be placed on the current use and misuse of stimulants such as caffeine and amphetamine; minor tranquilizers such as chlordiazepoxide (librium) and diazepam (valium), and major tranquilizers such as chlorpromazine (thorazine) and alcohol.

Registration is now open for the six-week session beginning July 6 and ending August 14, 1981.
