RESOLVED, That the sincere gratitude of the people of the city and of this Common Council is hereby expressed to MISS ELLEN B. SCRIPPS, of La Jolla,

for her generous act, which will always be regarded as a gift to the City of San Diego as well as to the interests sought to be furthered.
