

Phyllis Curtin will present recital in La Jolla on April 8

Internationally known Phyllis Curtin, American-trained soprano who has made a sensational success with European opera houses as well as in the United States, will present a recital in La Jolla on Sunday, April 8.

Miss Curtin sings at Sherwood Hall, Art Center in La Jolla, at 8:00 p.m. under the auspices of the University of California's All-University Concert Series.

Her program will include songs by Handel, Mozart, Brahms, Barber, and Rodrigo, and arrangements of Argentinian folk songs by Ginastera.

One of the most beautiful women and accomplished actresses on the operatic stage, Miss Curtin has appeared in the Metropolitan Opera and New York City Opera and in many European Opera Houses, most recently in Vienna. She is also well-known for her appearances in televised operas in this country.

Her appearance in La Jolla has been possible by a recent endowment which enables the University of California to present world-famous artists in the University communities of the State.

Tickets for the performance cost \$1.00 for students and \$2.50 general admission. The student tickets are available to any student in the San Diego school system or local colleges and universities. Performance time is 8:30 P.M.
