

Journalist David Halberstam will lecture

March 29, 1976

Pulitzer Prize winning journalist David Halberstam, author of "The Best and the Brightest," will lecture on "The Uses and Abuses of Power" at 8 p.m. Tuesday, April 6, in the Mandeville Auditorium at the University of California, San Diego.

One of America's most distinguished and controversial journalists, Halberstam has been called a "legend in American journalism" by Harper's magazine. Tickets for the lecture, sponsored by the Campus Program Board, are \$2 for general admission and \$1 for UCSD students.

A 1955 Harvard graduate, Halberstam joined the New York Times in 1960 as a foreign correspondent. While reporting for Time, he won the Pulitzer Prize in 1964 for his dispatches from Vietnam.

Speaking with authority on the political issues of concern to Americans, he discusses Watergate, the growth of presidential power and the strained relationship between government and the media.
