UCSD ALUMNI ASSOCIATION TO SELECT REPRESENTATIVE TO SERVE ON UC BOARD OF REGENTS FOR TWO YEAR TERM

Applicants are being sought among alumni of the University of California, San Diego, to serve a two-year term on the UC Board of Regents as Alumni Regent.

The appointment will begin July 1, 1993, and extend to June 30, 1995. Deadline for applications to the Office of Alumni Relations at UCSD is May 14, after which a search committee will review and interview applicants. Final selection will be made by the UCSD Alumni Association Board of Directors June 1.

Bernadine Farrow, director of the UCSD Alumni Association, noted that the Alumni Regent appointment rotates among the UC campuses, so the opportunity for a local appointment occurs only every seven years.

Criteria established by the committee includes that the candidates (1) hold a degree from UCSD; (2) have knowledge of the issues facing the University and UCSD; (3) demonstrate an ability to represent alumni concerns, issues and views and bring these to the Regents; (4) be able to commit the estimated four to six days monthly to accomplish Regent/UCSD business; (5) have a continuing history of service with UC or UCSD on committees or boards.
