

Breakdown of the students registered at UCSD including med students, SIO etc.

A total of 9,627 undergraduate, graduate and medical students have enrolled in fall quarter classes at the University of California, San Diego according to the final registration report released this week by Ronald J. Bowker, registrar and admissions officer.

The total is an increase of 752 students over the number officially enrolled during the 1974 fall quarter. Most of the increase is at the undergraduate level.

According to Robert W. Starkey, UCSD analytical studies officer, fall enrollment is about 300 students more than campus officials had planned for one year ago, but the situation has little affect on UCSD's long-range growth schedule.

"We'll just grow a little slower in the next few years. We're still scheduled to reach a steady state enrollment of 8,000 undergraduate and 2,000 graduate students by 1978," Starkey said.

Official registration figures are gathered by the Office of the Registrar at the end of the third week of classes for submission to UC President David S. Saxon. The report includes the number of lower division and upper division undergraduate students plus all graduate students including those in the Scripps Institution of Oceanography and School of Medicine and other health professionals.

The report lists 7,596 undergraduates, 664 more than last year, with 2,472 enrolled in Revelle College, 3,033 in John Muir College, 1,219 in Third College and 872 in Fourth College.

According to the report, the School of Medicine enrolled 687 students, up 63 from last year. The figure includes 319 M.D. candidates and 368 interns and residents.

New programs for allied health professionals and nurse Practitioners enrolled 32 and 31 students respectively.

The Graduate Division enrolled 1,344 students, including 190 at Scripps, up 25 from last year's enrollment.
