IS WARREN CHRISTOPHER FIT TO BE THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMISSION INVESTIGATING THE LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPT.?

Recently, A black man by the name of Rodney King was beaten by members of the Los Angeles Police Dept.. Warren Christopher, the manager of A 500 lawyer legal firm was appointed Chairman of the Commission to investigate the situation. Bill Boyarsky, in An Article printed May 3, 1991 in the Los Angeles Times, ENTITLED "Echoes of the McCone Commission" gives information About Christopher,

In 1965, there was the Watts Riot in the main blacks Area in Los Angeles, where many stores and residences had been looted and burned and several people killed and quite A few injured. John McCone WAS Appointed Chairman and Warren Christopher was made Vice Chairman OF A COMMISSION TO INVESTIGATE.

Boyarsky writes that it was Warren Christopher who was the main writer of the McCone Report. The U.S. Civil Rights Commission describes this Report as "Elementary, superficial, unoriginal, and unimaginative." Boyarsky writes that the L.A. Police Dept. was examined but report IGNORED racism and brutality.
