

## Dr. Gabriel Jackson appointed Associate Professor of History.

Dr. Gabriel Jackson has accepted appointment as Associate Professor of History at the University of California, San Diego, it was announced today by University President Clark Kerr and San Diego Chancellor John S. Galbraith.

Dr. Jackson comes to UCSD from Knox College, Galesburg, Illinois., where he served as Associate Professor of History since 1962. He was a faculty member at Wellesley College, Goddard College and the Putney School.

He received his A.B. degree in 1942 from Harvard College, his M.A. in history in 1950 from Stanford University and his Doctorat d'universite in history in 1952 from the University of Toulouse (France). The recipient of several fellowships, Dr. Jackson studied in Toulouse on a Fulbright Fellowship, in Spain on Fulbright Post-Doctoral and Social Science Research Council Fellowships, and in Mexico on a Sheldon Travelling Fellowship.

He is a member of the American Historical Association, Phi Beta Kappa, and the American Association of University Professors.

The author of numerous articles and reviews, Dr. Jackson recently published a book entitled The Spanish Republic and the Civil War. He presently serves as Consultant to the Hispanic Foundation of the Library of Congress on purchases in the field of Spanish history.
