INTRODUCTION

The patrol was mounted on the Put Put coastal area, villages of MERAI, GAR and LAT were also visited, for the duration of three days.

Objects of the Patrol were to:-

- (a) Locate and establish the villagers who are living on the Put Put land owned by Catholic Mission.
- (b) Estimate number of hectares under improvement in all YAMAS, PUT PUT Plantations and KAMBUBU S.D.A. Mission land. At the same time ascertain their plans of improving the remaining properties.
- (c) Check the progress of the R.I.P. road projects from TALILIS Plantation to Sum Sum Plantation.
- (d) Publicise the Independence date.
- (e) Discuss with the people the "Village Court System".

PATROL MOVEMENT

Due to a very short time and a vast area that the patrol had to cover, a Toyota Land Cruiser from YAMAS Plantation was hired to speed up movement. It was also a rainy period and with the use of this vehicle it was not difficult moving from place to place.

LAW AND ORDER

There was no serious offence of any kind reported to the Patrol.

Two Luluai's died two weeks before I went to the area. One from LAT village and the other from MERAI. These two people have been very good leaders in that they have been able to keep peace and good order in their respective villages. Arrangements should be made to appoint new Luluais at present I told the Tultuls to act as Luluais for a while until someone is appointed for the position.

PATROL INSTRUCTIONS -- KOKOPO NO. 3 of 1973/74

As discussed with you recently, please be prepared to depart on patrol to Put Put area in the Coastal Baining area on Tuesday 30/4/74 for the duration of three to four days.

The objects of your patrol are as follows:-

- (1) Locate and establish the villagers who are said to be living on the Put Put Land owned by the Catholic Mission.
- (2) Estimate number of hectares under the improvement. While you do this you should also estimate how many hectares under improvement of both Kambubu SDA Mission and Yamae. You should also ascertain their plans of improving the remaining properties.
- (3) Carry out a check on the progress of the R.I.P. road projects from Talilis Plantation to Sum Sum Plantation and make a brief report on your return.
- (4) You should bring along some publicity notes with you to publicise the Independence date. You should explain that the Chief Minister has just thrown open the date as 1st December, 1974, for everyone to think about as date of Independence. The Members of the House of Assembly are now getting the views of their people in their respective electorates and the date of Independence will be discussed during the coming June sittings. You should also make it clear to them that the date of Independence will be 1st of December 1974, or there after.
- (5) Another topic you should discuss with the people is the "Village Court System". You were provided with a copy of this Ordinance passed by the House of Assembly in November, 1973. It has not been assented to by the Governor General.
- (6) Police, Kokopo, have agreed to provide a member of the Police to accompany you on this patrol and you should liaise with them.
- (7) You should attend all the complaints and you should be able to settle the minor ones but refer the ones which need Court action to Kokopo Local Court.
- (8) You may draw out sufficient patrol advance before your departure.

I wish you a successful patrol.
