March 2-Apr. 7 -- Mandeville Gallery, UCSD, will simultaneously exhibit two collections of Ansel Adams' works, "Fiat Lux" and "The Museum Set." Gallery hours are noon to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Sunday. Admission is free. One hundred never-before exhibited prints of the University of California's campuses, research centers, natural reserves and people are represented in the "Fiat Lux" exhibition, which premiered at the University of California, Irvine in January. The "Museum Set" is a collection of 75 images chosen by Adams to best represent the breadth of his work. The collection is owned by Pacific Telesis; the exhibition, which will travel to six UC campuses and two public museums, is sponsored by Pacific Telesis.
