Loving of the Parish of Hanover and Island aforesaid am hold and firmly
bound unto Thomas Hall of the Parish of Saint James's and Island
aforesaid in the sum of Two Thousand Pounds Current
Money of Jamaica to be paid to the said Thomas Hall his Attorney, Executors
Administrators & Assignees to the which payment well and truly to be
made I bind myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators firmly by
these Presents Sealed with my Seal and Dated this twenty eighth
Day of February in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred
and Forty Nine.

The condition of the above written Obligation is such That
~~W~~illard George Godwin of the Parish of Westmorland aforesaid
aforesaid deceased Did by his last Will and Testament bearing date
the twenty ninth day of February One Thousand Seven Hundred and
Thirty nine / after Several legacies and other Provisions by him therein
made and given to the several Servants thereon mentioned) Give devise
and Bequeath all the rest residue & remainder of his Estate both real
personal & mixt of what kind and nature never lost Specified before disposal
of unto wife Elletson one of the Sons of his Daughter Sarah Ellerson and
in case of his death without issue of his Body Then he gives the same
and every part thereof to his Daughter Sarah Ellerson during her Lifetime
next and from and immediately after her Marriage or Death. He gives and
Bequeath the same and every part thereof between his Daughter Mary
Dehany surviving Children & their Heirs of Assign for ever part and part
alike Under which said general devise comprehended two Parcels or parcels
of Land in the Parish of Saint James's near Montego Bay Island aforesaid
One Parcel or Barrell containing Six Hundred acres Bounded by William
Gearworth bounding West on Captain Swinmons Land South on Mountain
west wood Land East on unpeopled Land and North on Thomas Ebbard
and Land not therewith: The second parcel or Barrell containing
Nine Acres Bounded by John Moore & Thomas Bridget bounding South on
Montego River West & North on left small Banks Land and East
on George Robertson — Lord ~~W~~illard by the Death of the said
wife Elletson without issue of his Body the right to the said two Parcels
or Barrels of Land fell and belong after the Marriage or Death of the
said Sarah Elletson to the Children surviving of the said Mary Dehany
Lord Wherell the said Thomas Hall has bargained with the said
David Dehany as guardian to & in name & behalf of Philip Dehany, Godwin
Dehany & Anne Dehany Minors three of the Children of the said Mary
Dehany, begotten of her Marriage with the said David Dehany his husband
for the absolute Purchase of their and each of their parts & shares of the
reversion of the said two Parcels or Barrels of Land to which they shall
have right at the Marriage or Death of the said Sarah Elletson; Lord
for all the right Title and Interest which they or any of them may
happen to have therein

shall and will at their attaining the age of Twenty one years compleat
Male & Female acknowledge & deliver to the said Thomas Hall
his Heirs & Assigns a good and secure title in Law of in and to their &
each of their parts of the reversion of the above recited two Parcies or Parcells
of Land. And of all the right title & interest which they or any of them
may happen to have therein containing a generall Warrant of all
deeds necessary: And if the said David Dehany his Heirs Executors
Administrators & Assigns or any of them do and shall at all and every
time or time hereafter well and truly indemnify & save harmlesly
the said Thomas Hall his Heirs Executors Administrators & Assigns
and all and every of them: And all and every their goods chattels
lands & tenements of and from all lost charges Damages and
expenses which shall or may arise or accrue to the said Thomas
Hall his Heirs Executors Administrators & Assigns or that they
or either of them may sustain through want of such secure Title
in law as aforesaid of in & to the said Philip Dehany Joakin
Dehany & Anne Dehany their parts of the above recited two Parcies
or Parcells of Land and of all the right and title claim & interest
which they or any of them may happen to have therein Then
this Obligation to be void & of no effect otherwise to be & remain
in full force and Virtue from
