

EUR AFAIRS :

The native situation in the SAU Valley is pair good. Since the establishment of the KOMPIAN Patrol Post in Origan 1983, the natives of the Upper Sau area have been in continuous contest with the administration, and at a result, they ere living peacefully. All groups is this area volunteered to work on the Kompian airstrip, and the motor road from Kompian to babaga.

i total of Sido names were recorded in the Upper Sau Cansus Sub-Division, but there was a large percentage of absenteelss due to the MOGA gift exchange ceremonies, and it is possible that the actual total would be searce six thousand.

All the groups cersured are living peacefully, and are co-operating with the Administration - the gaviest concentration of population being around the Government station at KOMPIAN. Tribal fighting has become a thing of the p - and all disputes are readily prought to KOMPIAN.

There are no Government-appointed Village Officials in the SAU Valley - such group has its own headman, who in actual fac' is very little more than a figure-head, as there are very few

The work on the sirstrip and road have also had a stabilising influence on the apopulation - groups that were proviously antagunistic towards each other are now working together towards a common goal.

Several new groups in the Lower Sau area were contacted for the first time - they were all friendly towards the Administration, and and heard of the Government station at KARPIAN. However, withough his area is not restricted, it is my epinion that it is not yet eare for his ion or other Mer-Government personnel to move about in this area.

Informatio: was gathered concerning other uncontacted groups ... ative reports indicate a large population north of the SAU - PD ON Rivers junction, whilst other groups were reported in the area north-east from LINGINGS. The B.C.A. - D.B.S serial survey of 1953 als o reported heavy population in this area north of the SAU - TOWN junction. Future patrols will endeavour to contact these groups.

A Police Essa Comp is maintained at LINGINAS, and several useful contacts with little-known groups have been made. Through this establishment.

There are only scattered groups to the area of the LAI - SAU junction, but heavier concentrations of population are found in the area around the SAU - TIMUN junction. It is setimated that the total population of them entire SAU Valley would be in the vicinity of 10,000 datives.

ROADS & BRIDGES 1

Apart from the motor road which is being hold from WABAGA to ECMPIAN, there are no other roads worthy of the name in the whole valley. The native foot tracks at best are hard walking, and at this time of the year, continuous teary rain turned the tracks into quagmires.

The WABAGA - KOWPIAM motor road is progressing well. It is now possible to drive 19 miles from WABAGA - to WABAGA - to WABAGA at the head of the SAU Valley. Construction has also been commenced from KOMPIAM - at present, about a mile of road has been completed, and the bridge across the ARUBAKE kiver south of KOMPIAM 1 under construction. the z taple diot, supplemented by sugar case, bananas, taro, pora, pit and sucumbers.

Buropean-introduced vegatables that are doing well include tomatoes, potatoes, beans, peas, pinkapples, peasure and papers.

The numes mound method of plenting west potato is carried out in some parts of the walley, but it is not universal, and this method is the only type of fertilization practiced by the natives.

The agricultural methods in use by the natives naturally leave much to be desired. The principles of soil erroion and contour planting have been explined to the people, but in cost cases they are content to follow the old methods.

ERUICAL & HEALTH :

Buropean Medical Assistant Wr. T. Souness from WABAGA secompanied the patrol and esseled out inspections of the Aid rosts on the area, besides correctly out a medical check-up on the people censused.

The health of the peoples visited appears to be remarkably good. Very few tropical ulcars, yaws sto. were seen - even in the Lower SAU area where these infections could be expected

MISSIONS :

The only Mission body in the area is the Baptics Mission at LIBUS, come 20 sinutes walk from KOMPlan. At present, the Mission staff consists of Mr. and Mrs. C. Craig, and Sister W. Shaw.

The nativer in the immediate violaity of the Mission are quite co-operative towards the Mission, and quite a few youngsters attend the Mission school. The Missions' medical work is also progressing natisfactorily.

MINIES :

There are three Suropean mining camps in the SAU Valley, and all are situated on the TIMUS River. At present, Mr. M. L. Wilson is on leave, an a Messre. A. E. Wilson and S. Re lands are in the area.

The plan was apparently a very detailed one various not were marked to hold the Europeans and police, whilst others were detailed to do the actual attack with tomahanks. When staff and time are available, a strong patrol will again investigate this area.

Although the attack did not eventuate, this further emphasizes the point made proviously that the Lower Sall area (although not restricted) is not yet safe for Mission or other non-Government personnel to move about in.
