UCSD VISITORS PROGRAM OFFERS TWO VARIED CAMPUS TOURS

Visitors to San Diego and longtime residents alike have the option of joining either free walking tours or bus tours of the beautiful University of California, San Diego campus this summer.

Designed for adults who would like general information about the campus as an educational and cultural resource, the tours are sponsored by the UCSD Visitors Program.

The 90-minute "Sunset Walking Tours" will leave at 6 p.m. every Thursday from June 25 through Aug. 27, 1992. Participants should wear walking shoes.

The free bus tours will be held the first and third Sunday of each month from 3 to 4 p.m., beginning July 5. Reservations are a must for these new Sunday bus tours.

Highlights of the tours include undergraduate college campuses, theaters, galleries, recreational facilities, the Price Center, the Central Library, portions of the Stuart Collection and an overview of the science facilities. Additionally, the bus tour includes the new UCSD medical facilities east of Interstate 5 and the Scripps Institution of Oceanography Aquarium-Museum.

Both tours leave from the Information Pavilion on Gilman Drive. There is a minimal parking fee. For information and reservations call the Visitors Program at 534-4414.
