

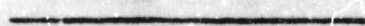

IN REGARD TO THE COMMENT RE THE PRESENT MEMBER WHICH COMES UNDER THE ABOVE HEADING IN THE AREA STUDY OF '73, IT SEEMS THAT SUINIVI OTIO IS NOW TAKING AN ACTIVE INTEREST IN THE YAGARIA PROGRESS SOCIETY. FROM THE D.A.S.F. OFFICER'S COMMENTS IT APPEARS THAT HE IS QUITE INFLUENTIAL. FOR EXAMPLE, SUINIVI DECIDED TO DROP TOBACCO AND THE OTHERS FOLLOWED SUIT.

PEANUTS:

LARGE GARDENS ARE OPERATIVE OR BEING PREPARED AT FORE FOR POSE AND AT LAGAIYU (2) FOR SAPU. OVER 2,000 lbs. OF SEED HAS BEEN DISTRIBUTED IN SMALL AMOUNTS THROUGHOUT THE SUB-DISTRICT, BUT IT CAN NOT BE ESTIMATED HOW MUCH ACREAGE HAS BEEN PLANTED BECAUSE MUCH OF IT WAS PLANTED WITHOUT SUPERVISION. UNFORTUNATELY VIRGINIA RINCH SEED WAS USED AND WE HAD TO DISTRIBUTE LESS SUITABLE WHITE SPANISH SEED.

POSE'S LOAN WHICH WAS RAISED TO ESTABLISH HIS PEANUT PLANTATION AT FORE HAS STILL A LONG WAY TO GO BEFORE IT IS REPAYED.

TOBACCO:

THE LAST CROP WAS LARGELY A FAILURE..DUE TO INEXPERIENCE BY PLANTERS AND LACK OF CO-OPERATION BETWEEN D.A.S.F. AND THE COMPANY INVOLVED. NONE OF THE OLD PLANTERS HAVE REPLANTED. SOME INTERESTED PARTIES ARE TRYING PLANTINGS AT KISAVEROKA BUT IT IS DOUBTFUL, WHETHER THEY WILL BE SUCCESSFUL AS THERE ARE MACHINERY PROBLEMS AND W.D.&H.O. WELLS DO NOT SEEM WILLING TO EXERT THEMSELVES.

POTATOES:

VIRTUALLY AN UNLIMITED MARKET AND THE YAGARIA SOCIETY INTENDS TO GO REGULARLY AND BUY THE PRODUCTION IN ORDER TO ENCOURAGE FUTURE INTEREST. THE PARTICULAR AREAS WHERE THE SOCIETY WILL BUY FROM ARE: LITIPINAGA; FRIGANO; DAGINAVA AND NUPURU.

RURAL DEVELOPMENT: UPDATE 1973.

THIS INFORMATION SHOULD BE READ IN THE LIGHT OF THE INFORMATION ON THE YAGARIA PROGRESS SOCIETY WHICH IS FOUND UNDER THE ABOVE HEADING, RURAL DEVELOPMENT, IN THE AREA STUDY CONDUCTED IN 1972.

THE INFORMATION BELOW IS TAKEN VERBATIM FROM THE ADVICE RECEIVED FROM THE D.A.S.F. REPRESENTATIVE AT KOREIYIGU RESPONSIBLE FOR EXTENSION WORK IN THE YAGARIA.

QUOTE: " Gradually whittling down debts.(\$1,300.00) remains at this stage. " END OF QUOTE. IT SEEMS THAT THE DEBT IS BEING WHITTLED DOWN BY THE SALE OF PEANUTS WHICH ARE PROCESSED BY THE YAGARIA PROGRESS SOCIETY AT OLIGUTI.

QUOTE: " Small quantities of peanuts locally grown, but doing everything, possible to revive interest and confidence in the crop. At present travelling to Markham at least once a fortnight to buy peanuts for cooking. Members interest (i.e. members of the YAGARIA PROGRESS SOCIETY) is not high...understandable because of the lack of activity It is aimed to proceed carefully with the society and ensure that it is truly established before expanding again. There is a real future for it, with peanuts as the basis. One of the major problems to be faced is its management. " END OF QUOTE.

COMMENT: Overall, taking into account that rural development activities have been going on in the YAGARIA for over a decade, the picture in the YAGARIA is not particularly encouraging. Coffee remains the base support of the emerging cash economy, supplemented only and spasmodical y by those ventures referred to in this report. There appears to be a combination of factors which have retarded development These are: Drastic fluctuations in market prices.....land disputes.... the failure of experimental projects such as tobacco.....the inability of D.A.S.F. extension officers to maintain sustained surveillance of projects in the field.....lack of business acumen.. of local people.....who very often enter business for the status that is accrued immediately.....and probably the most influential factor which retards progress, is the apparent inability of business leaders, so called, to organise labour resources. Very wealthy men, (comparatively speaking) can afford to buy labour, such as Mr. SUIWIVI OTIO the member for the LUFA OPEN ELECTORATE....where as people like Pose of Fore who are not as wealthy must rely on promised help. Further, he is there by obligated to repay this promised help with money which eats into his personal profits.

THE PROJECT IS DOING WELL AND THE OWNER HAS TURNED OFF NEARLY 20 WEANERS DURING THE YEAR. HE WILL REPAY HIS LOAN EARLY NEXT YEAR.

ALL OTHER PIGGERIES ARE DEFUNCT, MAINLY THROUGH LACK OF CONSISTENT MANAGEMENT.

POULTRY:

A PROJECT IS BEING DEVELOPED AT UKUNUPI SCHOOL. (MEAT ONLY)

FISH:

ATTACHED IS A LIST OF FISH POND OWNERS. MANY OF THE PONDS ARE TOO SMALL AND NEED TO BE ENLARGED BEFORE THEY EVER BECOME AT ALL SIGNIFICANT AS A PROTEIN SOURCE. ACTIVITY IS KEEN (PARTICULARLY IN THE FRIGANO AREA.) BUT PROGRESS IS BEING HAMPERED BECAUSE WE ARE HAVING DIFFICULTY IN OBTAINING FINGERLINGS.

GOATS:

THE D.A.S.F. REPRESENTATIVE IN THE YAGARIA HAS ADVISED THE A.D.C. THAT D.A.S.F. WERE INTERESTED IN PROMOTING GOAT PROJECTS, BUT THERE HAS BEEN A SETBACK BECAUSE THE PEOPLE WERE ASKING \$40.00 FOR ONE GOAT.

THE INFORMATION IS BASICALLY A COMMENT ON THE STATE OF THE VARIOUS CATTLE PROJECTS IN THE YAGARIA.

THE FOLLOWING IS EXTRACTED VERBATIM FROM THE D.A.S.F. COMMENTS.

A. CATTLE: NO NEW CATTLE PROJECTS STOCKED SINCE DECEMBER 1972. ONE NEW LOAN PLACED FOR A SIX BREEDER UNIT AT FORE VILLAGE. THE BORROWER IS: SEVETI MORUFA.

PROJECTS ARE CONSOLIDATING GENERALLY.

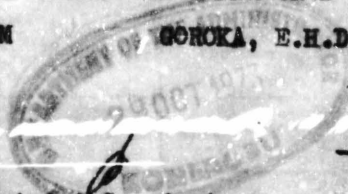

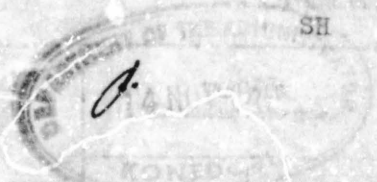

INTRODUCTION.

Para (1). This patrol commenced on the 26/11/73 and ended on the 7/12 '73. THE patrol was mounted to the Mengino (part) Labogai and the Agibu (part) Unavi areas. The main objective of the patrol was to find those sections of the road which needed immediate maintenance. The basic task which the patrol encouraged the people to do was to put 'across the road culverts' and make the side barrets wide and deep, and also explained their advantages. These I should say was done quite well. The people in the area patrolled have come to realize the fact that the road should be made trafficable, which would make it easier for their trade purposes as well as communication with the outside world.

I accompanied J.B.BRAY P.O.

Para(2). The patrol set up camp at Mengino P.O. and subsequently surveyed the road with the intention of finding those sections of the road which required immediate maintenance. The patrol had been allocated some money with which to draw up contracts for those sections which required maintenance of the type of work which could not be the responsibility of Monday maintenance workers, or the job which was too much for an individual.

Para(3). During the first week the patrol also visited a Agibu area and stayed at the rest house for two odd days. In those days at Agubi the patrol stressed to the people what was required to be done, as was done in Mengino No.1. Understandably the people did fire back the argument that 'why on earth should they continue to look after the road if it is not open to traffic vehicle inspite of their many years of hard work. It as surveyed is unopen to traffic due to one major section of the road, which could possibly, if not opened will prevent access to both Agotu and (Mengino) Agibu. This section is the one just above the Wamu river. The work involves the removal of enormous size boulders, and inclusive, the section is susceptible to frequent landslides which covers up much of the terrific work already done. When the patrol approached the section, it was discovered that a large slip had occurred recently and more significantly all the crow bars and the big wire lines were left around on the site. It looked very much as if the slip had made the people so heavy hearted that they did not feel like continuing with the work. On the bench through Mane no work had been done for a while to improve it or reopen it which is now covered with long grass and pit-pit bush.

Para(4) Although the people seemed resistant to road work they were strongly advised to look after their road or otherwise will face a hard task in reopening it again because the section of road on the Mengino 1 side down to Wamu River has been opened to traffic vehicle. The patrol informed the people that work will possibly commence soon to open up the section which is preventing access to their place.

Para(5) On Friday of the first week the patrol was unfortunately recalled to the station due to the SELF GOVERNMENT DAY. The patrol mounted back to Mengino 1. after the SELF GOVERNMENT weekend and surprisingly discovered that the voluntary workers have not done what was been explained and expected of them.

Para(6) It looked as if the work required would take such a long period for the voluntary workers to tackle, so a contract line of twenty-one men were recruited. These twenty-one men were then divided into two groups, one comprised of the Kiove men and the villages nearby and the other of the Oraratu No. 1 men. The patrol marked out thirty locations for the 'across the road' culverts which were specially designed to prevent the rain water which continually erodes the road and does not flow into the side gutters. I am quite certain that these culverts, which are bridged by nailed down timber, will stop the rain water which does keep on undoing much of the surfacing and general maintenance that has been carried out previously. All the culverts were well completed at the end of the contract period which was five solid days. THESE were done by the ten men from Kiovi and the nearby villages.

Para(7) On the other hand the eleven men from Oraratu No. 1 completed a major maintenance which involved the rebuilding of two sections of the road which are located about a quarter of a mile before the first bent into the Wamu river gorge. The sections had fallen away, leaving only one eighth of the width of the road, so were replaced by stones skilfully built up in layers. THESE sections seemed to have blocked the road but they were permanently restored.

Para(8) The Gono-Mengino-Wamu road is now open from Gono to the Wamu bridge. However it will be necessary to further improve the road at a later date because there are still numerous sections on this road that requires widening and deepening of the gutters. THERE is also a need for a number of small culverts and a great deal of surfacing will ultimately be required too. In addition several bridges in the Gono-Yagasa area whose outside bearers and foundations had rotted away presented a danger to traffic, that requires mending. It is recommended that this take place as soon as is convenient.

Para(9) Due to the fact that the great amount of time spent on the road maintenance work, such issues like Political Education and Economics were not largely discussed. However these were attempted whenever the patrol had some few interested groups.

Para(10) (As stated)

POLITICAL

As stated Political Education was not largely discussed. To the few questions raised the people did not show much interest. This could be one of the reasons why the people still have this lack of Political understanding.

ECONOMIC

Para(11) There is nothing new and significant to report on the economic development of the area patrolled.

LAW AND ORDER

Para(12) There was only one matter requiring action at Local court or above was reported and this was an adultery case. Many minor civil complaints were brought up mainly marriage problems, debt to canteens and pig trespasses. All these were dealt with accordingly by the policeman. The defendant and the complainants involved in the adultery case were taken to Lufa Police Station, when the patrol was recalled to the station for the Self Government Day.

HEALTH

Para(*13) The standard of health in the area patrolled was fairly adequate. It was brought to the patrols notice that an old woman died in Mengino 1. during the Self Government weekend. When recalled to the station five sick people were taken in to Lufa sick-bay for treatment. No outbreak of sickness was reported to the patrol.

Para(*14) The people in Mengino 1. are still not happy with the deserted aid post. It was reported that the Aid Post was without a staff for at least eight months. They further claimed that they had requested for an A.P.O. But nothing had been done about it. Something like this would easily demolish the relationship that the people have with the Government. It has been told that we will try to staff the Aid Post.

Para(15) The former A.P.O.s house was pulled down so the patrol encouraged the people to erect a new house and a lavatory. Some afternoons were spent on the supervision of the buildings. At the patrols departure the Houses were three quarters finished.

CULT AND UNREST

Para(16) There was no obvious signs of cults or unrest in the area at the time of the patrol.

COUNCIL MATTERS

Para(17) While the patrol was in Mengino No. 1. the people of Mengino complained that they were not happy with their councillor. They RECKONED he does not inform them of the Council meetings and the matters discussed at the Council meetings, and claimed that the Council should stop paying him.

ROUTINE ADMINISTRATION

Para(18) Most villages visited were not in a satisfactory condition. The villages were unfenced with pigs, fowls and dogs excreta all over the place. On the patrols arrival to Agibu, the rest house and the police house were both in a poor condition. The roofs had great big holes and the walls were partly fallen down. The people were advised to dismantle the old houses and erect new ones before the next patrol to this area.

CONCLUSION

There is nothing of significance to report on the aspects of the social life of the people in the area patrolled. In conclusion I WOULD like to say that the patrol was a worth while one. From which I indeed learnt something of use as it was my history to mount a patrol since I joined this Dept.. I will be looking forward for future patrols in the future, and if given the chance I would greatly appreciate it each time.

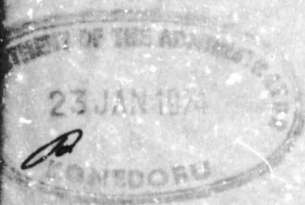
