BACKGROUND: The UCSD baseball team has been invited by the government of the People's Republic of China (mainland) to play a series of games in China during December. The UCSD team will be the first U.S. baseball team ever to play in mainland China.

At the press conference, the Chinese government will be represented by Mr. Liu Fen Zg Leng, manager of CAAC (Civil Aviation Administration of China) the national airlines of the PRC. Also attending will be San Diego County Supervisor Roger Hedgecock; UCSD athletic director Judy Sweet, and several members of the UCSD baseball team.
