

UCSD student receives Regent's Scholarship

Bruce D. Heitman and Eric Blinman are among 303 new University of California students who have been awarded Regents Scholarships this fall, University President Charles J. Hitch has announced.

A Regents Scholarship is one of the highest honors for undergraduate study at the University. The winners were selected on the basis of demonstrated academic excellence and exceptional promise. The amount of each scholarship is based on a student's financial need. Awards may be honorary or range up to the full cost of required fees, room and board, books and other expenses of the school year.

The 303 Regents Scholars are pursuing studies in 42 academic disciplines. The greatest concentrations are in the health sciences, mathematics biological sciences, chemistry, engineering and physics.

Heitman is a freshman at Revelle College on the University's San Diego campus. Blinman is a freshman on the Berkeley campus.
