

Northern Ireland art exhibition to open at UCSD Art Gallery

May 10, 1974

A multi-media art exhibition about Northern Ireland will open Wednesday, May 15, at the University of California, San Diego in the UCSD Art Gallery, room 1260 of the Humanities-Library Building on the Revelle campus.

Titled "The Troubles - An Artist's Document of Ulster." the show consists of photographs, audio and video tapes, newspaper panels, poetry, folk art and slides.

The exhibition explores the religious strife in Northern Ireland focusing on four areas - the people, noise torture, papers and documents and the culture.

New York artist Les Levine organized the collection which was first shown in 1972 at Finch College and has since been displayed in a number of locations throughout the country.

The show will continue through June 7. Hours are noon to 5 p.m. daily and 8 to 10 p.m. Wednesday. Video tapes will be shown at 3 p.m. Wednesday and Friday only.
