UCSD TO HOST FOURTH ANNUAL "ARTS AT UCSD" EVENT ON APRIL 25

"The Arts at UCSD," an annual "friend raiser" event sponsored by the University of California, San Diego Board of Overseers, will be held on April 25 in the UCSD Ida and Cecil Green Faculty Club and the Mandeville Center Auditorium.

This year's offering, titled "An Invitation to the Dance," will feature members of the UCSD Dance Program performing an abbreviated program during dinner, which begins at 6 p.m., followed by a full-length performance in the auditorium.

Prior to the performance, Stanley Chodorow, dean of the Division of Arts and Humanities, will present opening remarks, followed by Margaret Marshall, director of the UCSD Dance Program, who will comment on the presentation and give a brief overview of the UCSD Dance Program.

The dinner performance, "Come and See These Dancin' Feet," was choreographed by UCSD faculty member Kristin KuerbisArcidiacono. The full-length performance will include six original works choreographed by UCSD Dance Program faculty members Jean Isaacs, Margaret Marshall, Patricia Rincon and Judith Sharp.

Marshall has directed and shaped the dance program since she started it in 1976. A professional dancer and choreographer, Marshall has studied with many of the country's leading dance artists, and holds a master's degree in dance. She has served as the area artistic advisor for the National Society of Arts and Letters for several years. Last year, as the society's National Dance Chairman, Marshall coordinated the NSAL National Ballet Competition, which was held in Pittsburgh.

The Arts Event 1991 Committee is chaired by Janet Belport. Other members are Mary Berglund, Danah Fayman, Mara Lawrence, Barbara Mullins, Marie Olesen, Kay Stone and Carolyn Yorston.
