

Dr. S.S. Penner receives committee appointments.

Dr. S. S. Penner, Professor and Chairman of the Department of the Aerospace and Mechanical Engineering Sciences at the University of California, San Diego, has received appointment to committee positions in two important astronautics organizations.

He has been elected a Corresponding Member, Engineering Sciences Section, of the International Academy of Astronautics, International Astronautical Federation; and has been appointed a member of the Publications Committee of the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics.

In addition, Dr. Penner has also been appointed a member of the Engineering Sciences Research Evaluation Committee of the Air Force Office of Scientific Research.

Dr. Penner was the first faculty member appointed to the engineering faculty at UCSD. He joined the faculty on January 1, 1964, from a position as director of the Research and Engineering Support Division of the Institute for Defense Analyses at Washington, D.C. Before coming to UCSD, Dr. Penner had contributed more than 100 publications in books and technical journals dealing with combustion and propulsion problems, radiant heat transfer, spectroscopic investigations and studies in chemical physics.
