



MAGNETIZED HEADS CAN CAUSE NOISE

Residual magnetism that builds up in a playback head during use can not only permanently reduce the high frequencies of a recorded tape, but can also permanently increase hiss on the tape. Smart recordists play it safe by demagnetizing their recorder's heads on a regular basis. This job is practically automatic when you use the Ampex cordless, all-in-one, tape head demagnetizer and head cleaner, Model #220. Ask for it at your Ampex tape dealer.
